Suicide affects hundreds of thousands of people each year.

About 30,000 people take their own lives.

Another 500,000 attempt suicide.

What increases the risk of suicide:

Depression

Other Mental illness

**Alcohol Abuse** 

Other drug use

Family history of suicide

Having a serious illness

Past suicide attempts

A major personnel loss or stressful life event (such as a death of a love one). **Warning Signs:** 

Talk about suicide
Prepare for death

Be deeply depressed

Show changes in personality

Act recklessly

How Can You Help:

Give emotional support Encourage person to keep

busy

Get away for a while

Exercise

Reduce stress by learning relaxation methods or enjoying a hobby.

Encourage the person to seek professional help.

If you are thinking of about suicide:
